- Requesting My Payment
  - *What do I need to do to get my payment?*

- Receiving My Payment
  - *Will my payment be reduced or offset if I owe tax, have a payment agreement with the IRS, owe other Federal or state debt or owe money to other debt collectors?*
  - *Will my payment be offset if my spouse or I owe past-due child support?*
  - *Will my second payment be issued on a debit card (the EIP Card)?*
  - *If I received my first Economic Impact Payment on an EIP Card, will my second payment be deposited on that same EIP Card?*

Eligible individuals who did not/do not receive an Economic Impact Payment – either the first or the second payment – will be able to claim it when they file their 2020 taxes in 2021. The IRS urges taxpayers who didn't receive a payment this year to review the eligibility criteria when they file their 2020 taxes; many people, including recent college graduates, may be eligible to claim it. Constituents will see the Economic Impact Payments (EIP) referred to as the Recovery Rebate Credit (RRC) on Form 1040 or Form 1040-SR since the EIPs are an advance payment of the RRC.
