Know Your Rights as a Federal Employee: If you are a federal employee who has been terminated because of Trump's actions, consider these resources and steps you can take to help:

- 1. Visit the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) website for information on "Employee Rights and Appeals."
- Visit the Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB) website for information about <u>"Prohibited Personnel Practices (PPP)"</u> and the steps to file an appeal. Federal employees by law are entitled to a written notice of termination, and the effective date of separation. <u>Other MSPB Sources: New Information Sheet on Probationary Termination (02/21/2025);</u> and How to File an e-Appeal.
- 3. <u>Get a copy of your "SF-50 Notification of Personnel Action" form from **OPM**. This is a record of your employment history (e.g., positions, pay, appointments, etc.).</u>
- 4. <u>Contact your union representative or human resources department for guidance. Also</u> <u>consider contacting your own individual attorney.</u>
