FEDERAL PROBATIONARY WORKERS FIRED

Since taking office, Trump has fired at least 24,000 federal employees across more than 18 federal agencies. Source: Federal Register,

HEAD OF NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD FIRED

On January 27, 2025, Trump ordered the firing of Gwynne Wilcox, the first Black female board member and first Black female who served as chair. Citing, "Heads of agencies within the Executive Branch must share the objectives of [his] administration". Source: JustSecurity Litigation Tracker

FOREIGN AID FUNDS FROZEN

On January 20, 2025, Trump issued an Executive Order to freeze USAID funding to foreign countries, non-governmental organziations, contractors and more.

DEMOCRATIC WINS

FEDERAL WORKERS REINSTATED

HEAD OF NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD REINSTATED

A federal judge ordered the Trump
